Alcohol

To ensure a safe, fun event for all please note that in line with Randwick Council regulations no alcohol is permitted to be consumed on the beach or in Bicentennial Park

How to get there

Entry to Yarra Bay Beach is by foot, through the club carpark and down the side of the club. Cross over the boat ramp and meet on the smaller section of beach on the left hand side of the breakwater.

Parking

Please follow the directions of the flotilla volunteers

No parking will be available at the Yarra Bay Sailing Club carpark

Limited parking is available at the Bicentennial Park parking area, but this area is expected to fill quickly

Additional parking is available on the main oval at La Perouse Public School via a gold coin donation for the school, or in surrounding streets.

Recycling/Rubbish

Please recycle into the bins provided and place any non-recyclable items, food scraps, etc into the waste bins provided

Amenities

Toilets are available on the northern side of the Bicentennial Park

Food, coffee and beverages will be available from the club's lower bar.

Please note that alcohol is not permitted to be consumed outside the club's premises.
